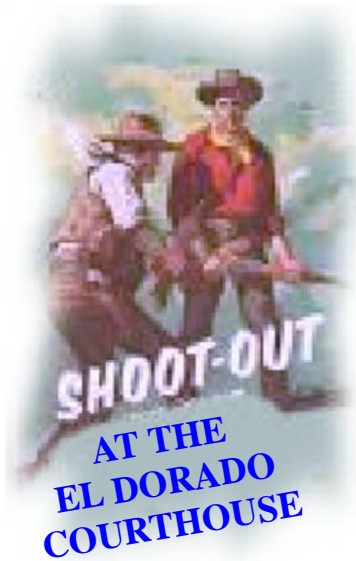

THE 1902 GUNFIGHT ON THE EL DORADO COURTHOUSE SQUARE

On Thursday October 9, 1902. a blazing gunfight erupted on the courthouse square in downtown El Dorado Arkansas. On one side was City Marshal Guy B. Tucker, his friend Constable Harrison Dearing and other supporters. On the other side were four of the Parnell brothers, part of a family of local business men and farmers. The gunfight grew out of a complicated series of events that included a romantic triangle and an argument over a sidewalk. Three men died that day and it sparked a long running feud in Union County.
